FACE (Functional And Cosmetic Excellence)

The orthodontic community has changed enormously over the years. In a competitive setting where sales of cosmetic products make up the majority of orthodontic treatments - we must restate our belief that the present and future of our profession are based on clinical excellence. FACE understands orthodontics as a specialty whose purpose is integral oral health, in addition to esthetics. Therefore, the aims of a stable functional occlusion, in addition to dental and facial esthetics, are goals that cannot be waived. Over many years, our group has accumulated a vast amount of clinical experience, which has been backed by clinical studies and evidence and which, little by

little, has led us on the path to excellence. Nothing has changed in the philosophy we defend. It is still the guide that focuses us on attaining our aims. However, the onset of new technologies in the last few years, in diagnostic as well as in mechanical aspects, has led us to compare factors not possible to determine previously. This obliges us to query certain aspects of tooth positions and other mechanical options. A painstaking investigation backed by clinical evidence enables us to update our technique and determine more precise values for the prescription, to help us to resolve common problems and focus more easily and quickly on achieving our aims.

(FACE Principles, Goals and Treatment Mechanics):

How is FACE Orthodontics different?

Four principles of FACE based orthodontics:

1. Proper Joint Function
2. Functional Occlusion
3. Anterior Guidance
4. Facial Balance and Esthetic

Goals of FACE treatment:

- Dental Esthetic and Facial Harmony
- Functional Occlusion
- Airway patency
- TMJ Health
- Long Term stability
- Periodontal health
- Patient satisfaction

Diagnostic requirements for a complete diagnosis.

Treatment mechanics to meet FACE goals for:

1. Class I malocclusions in permanent Dentition
 - Detailed objectives for each of the 3 stages
 1. *Leveling/aligning*
 2. *AP/vertical/transverse correction*
 3. *finishing*
2. **Class II malocclusions in Permanent Dentition in both favorable facial patterns and unfavorable facial patterns**
 - a. *Differentiating favorable/unfavorable growth patterns*
 - b. *Class II treatment in Mixed Dentition*
3. **Class III malocclusions in mid-face deficiency cases (From middle mixed dentition, permanent and adult dentitions)**

FACE based Orthodontics in Inter disciplinary cases.

If you offer any interdisciplinary treatments, a dedicated FACE team is most important for optimal and predictable treatment outcomes.
